1. The hearing has been conducted through Video Conferencing.
2. Petitioner – facing trial in case FIR No.189/2017 under Section 302/34 IPC registered at police station Badarpur – is seeking regular bail.
3. The nominal roll states the petitioner was earlier granted interim bail on 21.10.2020 till 23.11.2020.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is covered by High Powered Committee Guidelines dated 11.05.2021, hence he request that the petition be treated as petition seeking interim bail.
5. In the circumstances, the petition is treated seeking interim bail under the High Powered Committee Guidelines dated 11.05.2021 which says that under trial prisoners (UTPs) facing trial for a case under Section 302 IPC and are in jail for more than two years with no involvement in any other case can be considered for grant of interim bail for a period of 90 days.
6. The nominal roll states that he has no other involvement in any other case and has undergone sentence of 3 years and 11 months approx. till 17.05.2021.
7. In the circumstances, the accused/petitioner is hereby granted interim bail for a period of 90 days from the date of his release on executing a

personal bond of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court/Duty MM.

8. The petitioner is directed to furnish his contact details/address to the Investigating Officer and shall make video call to the Investigating Officer in the first week of every month and shall keep his mobile location app open at all time. He did not misuse the liberty when he was earlier granted interim bail.

9. The petitioner will not contact or threaten the witnesses in any manner, lest it shall be a ground for cancellation of bail.

10. The petition stands disposed of in above terms.
