Learned counsel for the accused submits that the accused is of old age and is suffering from diabetes and high blood pressure and due to his pre-existing health condition, he is prone and at higher risk of contracting COVID-19. It is further submitted that the Jail Superintendent himself recommended for the bail.

Learned Addl. PP objects to the present application.

I have considered the submissions.

Considering the COVID-109 Pandemic, the directions of the Hon'ble High Court regarding decongestion of jails for ensuring social distancing and also considering the medical condition of the accused, the accused/ applicant Asif Khan is admitted to interim

bail for 45 days, on furnishing of bail bond of Rs.1,00,000/- along with a surety bond to the like amount, to the satisfaction of the concerned Duty Magistrate, subject to the condition that he shall not threaten, intimidate or influence the witnesses in any manner and shall not leave the territory of India without seeking prior permission of this Court.

The accused shall surrender before the Jail Superintendent on the immediate next day after expiry of 45 days from today i.e.15.04.2020.

Copy of this order be sent to the Jail Superintendent for intimation and be also uploaded on the Web Site of District Court. A copy of this order be further supplied to Ld. Counsel for the accused through e-mail.
